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### **Demographic Profile**

The population in Kirbyville, MO was 109 per American Community Survey data for 2018-2022.

The region has a civilian labor force of 42 with a participation rate of 44.7%. Of individuals 25 to 64 in Kirbyville, MO, 8.1% have a bachelor's degree or higher which compares with 35.8% in the nation.



# **Employment Trends**

As of 2023Q4, total employment for Kirbyville, MO was 213 (based on a four-quarter moving average). Over the year ending 2023Q4, employment increased 2.3% in the region.



# Wage Trends

The average worker in Kirbyville, MO earned annual wages of \$38,518 as of 2023Q4. Average annual wages per worker increased 4.5% in the region over the preceding four quarters. For comparison purposes, annual average wages were \$69,861 in the nation as of 2023Q4.

### **Cost of Living Index**

The Cost of Living Index estimates the relative price levels for consumer goods and services. When applied to wages and salaries, the result is a measure of relative purchasing power. The cost of living is 16.5% lower in Kirbyville, MO than the U.S. average.



### **Industry Snapshot**

The largest sector in Kirbyville, MO is Educational Services, employing 69 workers. The next-largest sectors in the region are Construction (65 workers) and Other Services (except Public Administration) (34). High location quotients (LQs) indicate sectors in which a region has high concentrations of employment compared to the national average. The sectors with the largest LQs in the region are Construction (LQ = 5.09), Educational Services (4.06), and Other Services (except Public Administration) (3.72).

Sectors in Kirbyville, MO with the highest average wages per worker are Transportation and Warehousing (\$63,463), Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services (\$61,223), and Wholesale Trade (\$52,688). Regional sectors with the best job growth (or most moderate job losses) over the last 5 years are Construction (+46 jobs), Other Services (except Public Administration) (+20), and Manufacturing (+4).

Over the next 5 years, employment in Kirbyville, MO is projected to contract by 3 jobs. The fastest growing sector in the region is expected to be Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services with a +0.8% year-over-year rate of growth. The strongest forecast by number of jobs over this period is expected for Retail Trade (0 jobs), Manufacturing (0), and Mining, Quarrying, and Oil and Gas Extraction (0).

### **Occupation Snapshot**

The largest major occupation group in Kirbyville, MO is Educational Instruction and Library Occupations, employing 48 workers. The next-largest occupation groups in the region are Construction and Extraction Occupations (40 workers) and Office and Administrative Support Occupations (24). High location quotients (LQs) indicate occupation groups in which a region has high concentrations of employment compared to the national average. The major groups with the largest LQs in the region are Educational Instruction and Library Occupations (LQ = 4.22), Construction and Extraction Occupations (4.09), and Community and Social Service Occupations (3.23).

Occupation groups in Kirbyville, MO with the highest average wages per worker are Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Occupations (\$91,900), Management Occupations (\$89,000), and Architecture and Engineering Occupations (\$86,000). The unemployment rate in the region varied among the major groups from 2.9% among Transportation and Material Moving Occupations.

Over the next 5 years, the fastest growing occupation group in Kirbyville, MO is expected to be Healthcare Support Occupations with a +0.7% year-over-year rate of growth. The strongest forecast by number of jobs over this period is expected for Educational Instruction and Library Occupations (0 jobs) and Construction and Extraction Occupations (0). Over the same period, the highest separation demand (occupation demand due to retirements and workers moving from one occupation to another) is expected in Educational Instruction and Library Occupations (20 jobs) and Construction and Extraction Occupations (17).



### **Education Levels**

Expected growth rates for occupations vary by the education and training required. While all employment in Kirbyville, MO is projected to contract 0.3% over the next ten years, occupations typically requiring a postgraduate degree are expected to grow 1.0% per year, those requiring a bachelor's degree are forecast to contract 0.1% per year, and occupations typically needing a 2-year degree or certificate are expected to grow 0.0% per year.

### FAQ

#### What is a location quotient?

A location quotient (LQ) is a measurement of concentration in comparison to the nation. An LQ of 1.00 indicates a region has the same concentration of an industry (or occupation) as the nation. An LQ of 2.00 would mean the region has twice the expected employment compared to the nation and an LQ of 0.50 would mean the region has half the expected employment in comparison to the nation.

#### What is separation demand?

Separation demand is the number of jobs required due to separations—labor force exits (including retirements) and turnover resulting from workers moving from one occupation into another. Note that separation demand does not include all turnover—it does not include when workers stay in the same occupation but switch employers. The total projected demand for an occupation is the sum of the separation demand and the growth demand (which is the increase or decrease of jobs in an occupation expected due to expansion or contraction of the overall number of jobs in that occupation).

#### What is a cluster?

A cluster is a geographic concentration of interrelated industries or occupations. If a regional cluster has a location quotient of 1.25 or greater, the region is considered to possess a competitive advantage in that cluster.

#### What is the difference between industry wages and occupation wages?

Industry wages and occupation wages are estimated via separate data sets, often the time periods being reported do not align, and wages are defined slightly differently in the two systems (for example, certain bonuses are included in the industry wages but not the occupation wages). It is therefore common that estimates of the average industry wages and average occupation wages in a region do not match exactly.

#### What is NAICS?

The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) is used to classify business establishments according to the type of economic activity. The NAICS Code comprises six levels, from the "all industry" level to the 6-digit level. The first two digits define the top-level category, known as the "sector," which is the level examined in this report.

#### What is SOC?

The Standard Occupational Classification system (SOC) is used to classify workers into occupational categories. All workers are classified into one of over 804 occupations according to their occupational definition. To facilitate classification, occupations are combined to form 22 major groups, 95 minor groups, and 452 occupation groups. Each occupation group includes detailed occupations requiring similar job duties, skills, education, or experience.
